International Coordination of Research on Infectious Animal Diseases (ICRAD)

"One Health Approach to Zoonoses Research and Innovation"

Deadline for submission of proposals:

15th December 2021, 15:00 CET (Berlin)

This document announces the second international call on infectious animal diseases within the framework of the International Coordination of Research on Infectious Animal Diseases (ICRAD) ERA-NET¹.

The main purpose of this call is to support multi-disciplinary research and innovation that will adopt a One Health approach to understand zoonoses by focussing on animal-humanenvironment interface.

Consortia must include a minimum of 3 partners from a minimum of 3 different countries, and a maximum of 8 partners. The consortium cannot include more than two partners from one country. Cross-sectorial and industry involvement are encouraged.

Applicants must respect eligibility rules of the call and the national/regional rules and regulations of their respective national/regional funding organisation as outlined in section 5 and Annex I of this document. In some cases, additional application to the national/regional organisation is necessary. Applicants are strongly advised to check the national/regional regulations provided in Annex I and to contact their funding contact points.

One Health Approach to Zoonoses Research and Innovation

The main purpose of this call is to support multi-disciplinary research and innovation that will adopt a **One Health approach** to understand zoonoses by focussing on **animal-human-environment** interface.

Cross-sectorial and industry involvement are encouraged.



II. Introduction to the Joint Call Thematic background

- The COVID-19 health crisis highlights how people and nature are interlinked, and how the human impact on the natural world may increase the risk of future pandemics.
- New and re-emerging infectious diseases including vector-borne diseases constitute a persistent threat for mankind and animals.
- There is an urgent and continuing need for new ways for detection, management, prevention and control (vaccines and diagnostics).



II. Introduction to the Joint Call Scope of the call

The overall goal of this ICRAD call is

- To support cross-cutting research and innovation to better understand zoonoses focussing on the animal-human-environment interface and by developing novel vaccine and diagnostics technology platforms to improve animal health and by consequence animal welfare.
- To prevent the emergence of zoonoses at source by understanding and mitigating the factors, or determinants, that influence primary infection and transmission is an important aim within scope of this call.

This call will cover viral, bacterial, parasitic, prion and fungal infections.



II. Introduction to the Joint Call Objectives (1)

Objectives:

- to increase preparedness to (re)-emerging zoonotic diseases and ability to respond to zoonotic threats and contribute to improved animal and public health.
- a concerted approach towards the development of novel and/or improved instruments to understand and control zoonoses, including detection, management, intervention and prevention strategies.



II. Introduction to the Joint Call *Focus of the Call*

Understand (re)-emergence of pathogens with zoonotic potential

Focusing on causes of pathogen (re)-emergence and factors (including vectors) that lead to **spill-over** and maintenance of pathogens. Improved understanding of ecology, evolution, cross-sector/species epidemiology, genetic, transmission, and persistence of pathogens in the environment will inform management and mitigation strategies.

Understand animal host-pathogen interactions and the immune response

Understanding **immunological processes and pathways**, and how they change during the course of infection will help **understand disease progression**, persistence, clearance, and replication of pathogens, and to tailor intervention strategies accordingly.

Develop detection and prevention platforms

Supporting the development of **novel diagnostic and vaccine technology platforms** will ensure preparedness for future disease outbreaks.

The research funded through this call is to improve health of livestock, therefore, research that mainly focuses on the below are not in scope of the call:

- × improving human health
- × antimicrobial resistance (AMR)
- × companion animals
- × climate/ecology/environment
- × food-borne pathogens
- × animal welfare

III. Conditions and requirements General Eligibility

- The application must be written in **English**
- Pre-proposals must be submitted by **15th December 2021** (15:00 CET Berlin) using the ERA-NET ICRAD submission website (www.submission-icrad.eu/call2).
- Max. duration of a project: **36 months**
- Industry and early career researcher participation encouraged, not mandatory



III. Conditions and requirements General Eligibility - Consortium Structure

- Min. of three eligible independent legal entities from a min. of three different partner countries.
- Maximum 8 per Proposal!
- Not more than two partners from 1 Country!
- Applicants from non-participating countries or non-eligible applicants can participate on their own costs (associated partners)
- Associated partners will also count

towards the maximum number of 8 partners and 2 partners per country. But not to the minimum 3!

- The majority of participants in a consortium must be eligible and applying for funding by the ICRAD Funding Organisations participating in this call. More (!) partners than associated partners!
- Total eligible budget per country must not exceed 70 % of the total eligible project budget

Be really careful with your project consortium composition and better <u>ask the call secretariat</u> to be sure!!!!! If rules are not fulfilled your project will be ineligible \rightarrow No Funding!

4 Partners from 3 Countries, + 3 Associated Partners	Yes	All eligibility rules fulfilled
8 partners from 5 Countries, 0 Associated Partners, not more than two from one country	Yes	All eligibility rules fulfilled



III. Conditions and requirements National Eligibility

National eligibility criteria as described in the National Regulations:

- **<u>READ</u>** the national ANNEX!
- Which Research Area can be funded (Not all Funders fund all Research Areas!)?
- Budget per project (Some Funders have budget limitations per project or per partner!)
- Who can apply for funding (research institutions, SMEs, differs from funder to funder)
- Whether a submission of a national application is requested

Consult your National Contact Point!

Make sure every Partner in your proposal contacts the National contact point!

In case one partner of a project consortium is not eligible, the Call Board may reject the entire proposal.



III. Conditions and requirements Call Budget (in M€)

- Overall Call Budget: ~ 12.46 Mill €
- Different Budget per Country/Funder
- Please be aware of different maximum budget per project partner → It is also possible to stay well below the max. amount!
- Please discuss your proposed budget with your national contact point and make sure your project partners do so too.
- Total eligible budget per country must not exceed 70 % of the total eligible project budget in order to achieve balanced partnerships and ensure that responsibility and risks are shared. → make sure the budget in your project is well distributed, according to the tasks the partners have to fulfil

- Project & Partner information, incl. Tasks

- Indication on ethical issues

All information must be entered to the submission tool.

III. Conditions and requirements Project monitoring, meetings and reporting

- Partners from each funded project are expected to organise regular project meetings.
- At least two ICRAD Meetings, Coordinator obliged to participate
- Coordinators will be required to submit a mid-term and a final report to the funders about the results of their transnational project (in addition to reporting required by the national funding bodies).



The costs for the meetings should be included in the project budgets.

V. Evaluation: evaluation criteria of pre-proposals

Excellence

- a) Scientific quality of the proposal.
- b) Relevance of the project regarding the addressed research area and objectives of the call.

Impact

- a) Potential impact of the expected results for future animal and public health.
- b) Added value of transnational collaboration: gathering a critical mass of biological material, sharing of resources (models, databases, etc.), harmonization of data, sharing of specific know-how and/or innovative technologies, etc.

c) Potential for fostering a longer-term international network of researchers.

Quality and efficiency of the implementation

- a) Coherence and effectiveness of the work plan (for full proposals: including appropriateness of the allocation of tasks, resources and timeframe).
- b) Complementarity of the participants in the consortium.

V. Evaluation: decision-making

A minimum of 3 experts will evaluate each full proposal

As a result of the evaluation, a ranking list of the full proposals recommended for funding will be established.

Based on the ranking list, the funders will take the final decision for national/regional funding, following general guiding principles :

- Fund as many high-quality projects as possible;
- Balanced geographical representation (e.g. for proposals with the same ranking).

The outcomes of the funding recommendations will be communicated by the Call Secretariat to the project coordinators, who shall inform their respective partners
